PRIMARY FUNCTION

Facilitators are responsible for the effective delivery of the simulation procedural skills components of the Primary Care Paramedic program. Additional duties may also include the completion of didactic lecture components.

RESPONSIBILITIES

There are general/program responsibilities that may include but are not limited to the coordination and preparation of all simulation equipment, assisting in addressing learner needs, as well as disposable/consumable inventory responsibilities.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

Education: The ideal candidate will possess the following:

- A Primary Care Paramedic diploma from an accredited institution.
- Experience in the delivery of initial education, continuing education, or short course training.
- A certificate in Adult education would be considered an asset.
- A valid registration with the CPNS as applicable (or equivalent) is required.

Experience: A minimum of two years' experience as a licensed practitioner at the level of a PCP is required. Candidates should be active practicing paramedics Experience in managing a number of projects simultaneously may be considered an asset.

Skills and Knowledge: Must possess a strong understanding of the knowledge, skills and judgement required by a Primary Care Paramedic. Must have the ability to work with the Microsoft office suite of products. Be creative, innovative, and committed to lifelong learning, with an enthusiastic desire to teach. The ideal candidate must possess excellent interpersonal skills, as well as have strong verbal and written communication skills in English.
